

## **Health Professions Program Assessment**

### Learning outcomes

The Health Professions program has three student learning outcomes: (1) understand and be able to discuss the growth of and changes in the interdisciplinarity of the health professions, (2) demonstrate an understanding of the broad-based curriculum, with distribution electives in psychology, sociology, statistics and ethics, and (3) have designed and carried out a research project that engages centrally with a current area of Allied Health.

### Assessment methods

Each student in the Health Profession program must take one of these two capstone courses: IDS 375, "Research Practicum," or IDS 500, "Special Problems in Interdisciplinary Studies." These capstone courses can be used to assess student learning in the program.
