

THE HONOR SOCIETY OF PHI KAPPA PHI SCHOLAR AWARD

The Phi Kappa Phi Scholar Award honors those individuals who demonstrate the ideals of the Society through their activities, achievements, and scholarship. Awardees receive \$1,000 honoraria, a one year active membership and a recognition certificate. First presented in 1974, the Scholar Award recognizes excellence in teaching, research, and public service. This award is given once per biennium.

ELIGIBILITY & DEADLINE

1. Chapters and active members are encouraged to nominate one individual for this award; self-nominations are encouraged.
2. Although nominees are often faculty members at colleges and universities, a chapter or any active member may nominate an active Society member who is not institution-affiliated provided all criteria are met.
3. The nominee must be an active member with current dues paid as of February 15, 2012.
4. All materials must be submitted on or before February 15, 2012.

SELECTION CRITERIA

1. Distinguished record of past scholarly achievements.
2. Documented evidence of national or international prominence and visibility.
3. Demonstrated consistency of excellence in teaching and/or service.
4. Distinguished record of honors, publications, patents, inventions or other types of recognition for excellence and scholarly achievement.

PROCESS & EXPECTATIONS

After the Board approves the recipient, nominees, presidents of nominating chapters, or individual nominators will be informed of the results. The Award recipient will be presented with a check for \$1,000, a one year active membership in Phi Kappa Phi, a recognition certificate and an invitation to the Convention in August 2012. Travel, lodging and meal expenses incurred by the recipient in attending the Convention will be fully reimbursed according to the Society travel policy.

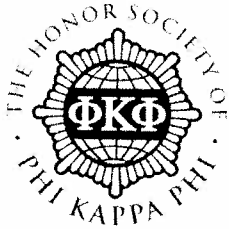

- The nominee's current and complete Curriculum Vitae or résumé, including a listing, with dates, of educational institutions attended and degrees taken, professional positions held, professional organization memberships and offices, honors and awards, and public performances, exhibits, publications or the like.
- The completed Nomination Form, with all blanks filled and boxes checked, signed by the chapter president or other nominator.
