## DEADLINE

Your completed application packet must be postmarked by April 1, 2012. Materials postmarked after the deadline will NOT be considered.

Winners will be announced by June 1, 2012.

## ELIGIBILITY

Open to any undergraduate student (you do not have to be a member) who meets the following requirements:

- Attend an institution with an active Phi Kappa Phi chapter;
- Have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.75 on a 4.0 scale (3.74 does not qualify);
- The study abroad program must begin between May 1, 2012 and June 30, 2013;
- Must have applied and/or been accepted into a study abroad program (provide the letter of acceptance on official letterhead as part of your application\*).

*\* If an official letter of acceptance is not available at the time of submission, then the applicant may obtain a letter from his or her school (on official letterhead) verifying the submission of an application and the student's intent to travel abroad.*
