Range of Cost: Approximately 16,000- 22,000 including room and board but not airfare

Credits earned: Approximately 12 but variable

Admissions Criteria: Sophomore in good academic standing, 2.5 minimum G.P.A., meet program specific requirements

Name: Institute For Study Abroad: Butler University

Locations: Internship and classroom programs in Australia, Chile, England, New Zealand, Ireland, Scotland. Classroom programs only in Argentina, China, Costa Rica, Egypt, India, Mexico, Peru, and Wales/

Summary: A mix of internship programs and classroom based programs, 90 universities in 15 countries.

Range of Cost: Can range anywhere from about 11,000 (Mendoza University program in Argentina including tuition, housing/meals but not airfare) to 22,000 (Oxford University: St. Edmund Hall, Oxford UK including tuition, housing/meals but not

airfare.) Fees for each program are outline on the website as well detailed info about what is included in the program fees.

Name: Salem State Language Intensive Programs

Locations: Ovideo- Spain, Florence- Italy, Quebec-Canada

Summary: Three summer programs that focus on language learning lasting 5-6 weeks

Range of Cost: Comparable to normal tuition at Salem State, (Spain = about 1,900 including lessons, course books, certificate, accident insurance, welcome and farewell parties, excursions and other cultural and recreational activities, room/board but not airfare and living expenses.) (Italy = estimated total including food but not airfare is 3,200 dollars) (Canada= estimated 2340 Canadian dollars plus living expenses and transport to Quebec.) Note: these fees are from previous years so contact the SSU Center for International Education for up to date costs.

Financial aid is available for these summer programs!

Name: UMASS AMHERST

Locations: Paris, Australia, Canada, China, Denmark, Ecuador, Egypt, Germany, India, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Korea, Mexico, Netherlands, South Africa, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Taiwan, England and more through external programs.

Summary: Programs in many countries that include studying at many international universities- less of a focus on internships in general though some programs may have them.

Range of Cost: Contact institution for more information

Credits earned: Be enrolled full-time in a U.S. college or university, Have completed your freshman year, Be in good academic standing: G.P.A. of 2.5 and above. (Some programs require 3.0 or better.), Have no outstanding disciplinary or judicial actions (all must be resolved before attending the program), Acquire written permission from your home institution, Get approval from the UMass IPO.

Credits earned: Generally 12- 15 for semester long programs

Admissions Criteria: Requirements vary by program but generally sophomore with at least 2.75 G.P.A. and some relevant language experience if applicable

Locations: Argentina, Chile, Costa Rica, England, France, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Mexico, Poland, Qatar, Spain, United Arab Emirates

Summary: The study abroad programs offer a range of coursework and are available for quarter, semester, summer, and academic year terms, as well as for two-week and month-long terms.

Range of Cost: Large range depending on what country (Ex. Chile= \$9,990 Paris= 14,000, London= 18,000 all prices not including airfare/ living expenses.)
