### MASTER OF ARTS IN TEACHING (MAT) SPANISH (ELEMENTARY) INITIAL LICENSURE

#### Objectives

Receive a Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT) in Spanish with initial licensure to teach Spanish at the elementary (P-6) level.
