New Academic Standing Advising Notes

Aim for 2.0 or better every semester

Advising Notes:

- ◆ **Carefully review student transcript for multiple withdrawals, Fs, Incompletes and NGs (no grades).**
- ◆ **Leave of Absences taken after the add/drop period result in W grades. These will be counted towards the following semester's academic standing, but not towards the semester in which they took the leave of absence.**
- ◆ **Think three times before advising a student to withdraw from a class or to register for more classes than they need.**
- ◆ **Advise students to pay attention to add/drop period—if the student knows she doesn't want the class after the first class meeting, she should drop within the add/drop period rather than waiting to withdraw.**
- ◆ **Consult with Academic Advising office if unsure about student's status or impact of academic standing.**
