

## **ABSENCE FOR RELIGIOUS BELIEFS**

Any graduate student who is unable to attend a class or to participate in any examination, study, or work requirement on a particular day of religious observance will be provided with an opportunity to make up that examination, study or work requirement, provided, however, that such make up shall not create an unreasonable burden upon the school. No fees of any kind shall be charged by the Graduate School for making this opportunity available to the student, and no adverse or prejudicial effects shall result to any student exercising this prerogative.
