

WITHDRAWAL FROM PROGRAM

Withdrawal from the graduate program can take many forms. A student may officially withdraw, be dismissed, take a leave of absence, or be administratively withdrawn. Withdrawal from the program implies withdrawal from all courses, and the graduate regulations concerning grades are applicable. Mere non-attendance does not constitute official withdrawal from the program. It is necessary to complete an official withdrawal form and file it with the Graduate School office. These forms are available from the program coordinator. Unauthorized withdrawal from the program or non-attendance (failure to register and attend Fall & Spring semesters) may result in administrative withdrawal.
