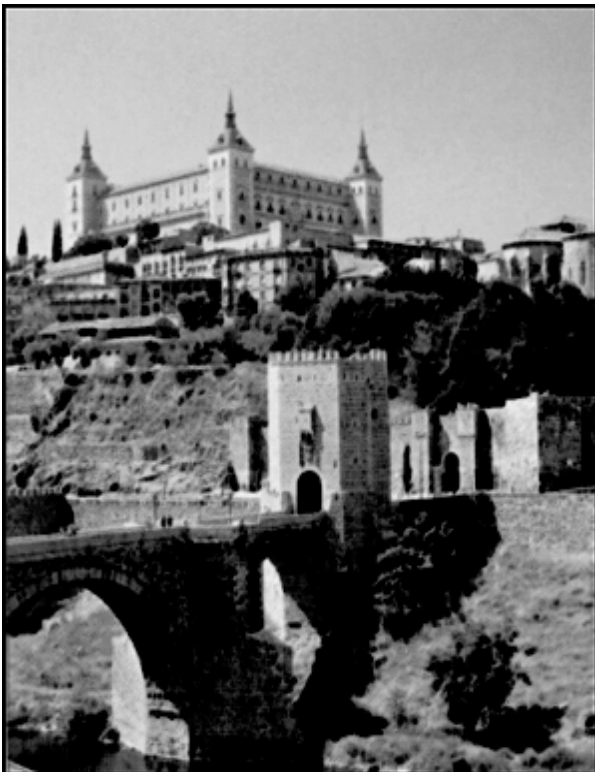

## **OUR SOUTHERN SPAIN AND NORTH AFRICA TOUR ITINERARY:**

**MAR 12– BOSTON-INTERMEDIATE CITY-MADRID:** Depart Boston's Logan International Airport aboard our transatlantic flight to Madrid (*via an intermediate city*) with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available in-flight.

**MAR 13 – MADRID, SPAIN:** Arrival at the airport in Madrid where we will be met by our Tour Escort who will assist with our transfer. Check-in at the 4-star *Hotel Mayorazgo* (or similar), centrally located in the historical, cultural and commercial district of the capital. The remainder of the afternoon is at leisure to familiarize ourselves with our surroundings. "Welcome Dinner" this evening at our hotel. Overnight. (D)

**MAR 14 – MADRID-TOLEDO-CORDOBA:** Breakfast and hotel check-out. Morning guided sightseeing tour in Madrid to see of many of the capital city's most famous and important landmarks. Depart Madrid, and head south into the Central Plain of Spain to picturesque Toledo, the Medieval fortress town built on a granite hill, and surrounded by the Tagus River on three sides. Toledo's rich heritage and unique architecture has been so well-preserved that the urban area has been declared a national monument. Our guided walking tour encompasses many of the outstanding sites of Toledo, including: Santo Tomé, Santa Maria la Blanca Synagogue, and its principal landmark – *the Cathedral* – most famous for the "Campaña Gorda", the largest bell in Spain weighing a staggering 17 tons. Continue driving south to Cordoba for check-in at our 4-star hotel (*to be determined*). Dinner and overnight. (BB, D)

**MAR 15 – CORDOBA-TORREMOLINOS:** Breakfast and hotel check-out. This morning, we will enjoy guided sightseeing in the 10<sup>th</sup> century town of Cordoba, one of the truly great cities of the world! Our tour guide will take us through narrow streets, Medieval settings, and expansive plazas to see many of Cordoba's historic venues, including a visit to the Mezquita, the 8<sup>th</sup> century former mosque. In the afternoon, we will continue our journey south to Torremolinos, on the Costa del Sol, for check-in at the 4-star *Hotel Cervantes* (or similar), which is adjacent to the beach and close to the local shopping center. Dinner at a local restaurant this evening. Overnight. (BB, D)

**MAR 16 – SEVILLE:** Breakfast at our hotel. Today, we are off to Seville to experience a wonderful guided tour of this fabulous Andalusian capital! We will visit the Cathedral (*the largest cathedral in Spain and resting place of the remains of Christopher Columbus*), the Giralda Tower (*a 12<sup>th</sup> century minaret which dominates Seville's skyline*), and the Barrio de Santa Cruz (*a labyrinth of alleys, shops and balconied houses*). Return to Torremolinos for dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight. (BB, D)

**MAR 17 – GRANADA:** Breakfast at our hotel. Full-day excursion to the center of splendor in Spain – magnificent Granada! Here, in the capital of Spain's last Moorish kingdom, we will visit the most outstanding example architecture of the period, the Nazari Alhambra, the fortress of the 13<sup>th</sup> century ruler, Al Ahamar. We will also visit the Water Gardens of the Generalife (*the Royal Summer Palace*) and the Royal Chapel (*erected in 1506-07 to house the remains of Ferdinand V and Isabella I*). Return to Torremolinos for dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight. (BB, D)

**MAR 18 – TORREMOLINOS-TARIFA-TANGIERS, MOROCCO:** Breakfast at our hotel. Morning transfer to the pier in Tarifa where we will board the hydrofoil for a brisk morning cruise across the Straits of Gibraltar to Northern Africa and the exotic port city of Tangiers, Morocco! Our guide will lead us through winding, narrow streets and colorful bazaars evocative of Tangiers' rich, historic past. We will also experience the modernization of this old world capital. Lunch at a local restaurant in Tangiers. Return to the mainland by hydrofoil and transfer to Torremolinos for dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight. (BB, L, D)

**MAR 19 – TORREMOLINOS:** Breakfast at our hotel. Today is an entire day at leisure to explore Torremolinos and the Costa del Sol area. Experience its sights, sounds and unique lifestyle that is the Costa del Sol on our own. Or maybe, do some last-minute shopping for that special gift. Or just relax at one of the numerous nearby fabulous beaches on the Costa del Sol! Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (BB, D)

**MAR 20 – MALAGA-INTERMEDIATE CITY-BOSTON:** Breakfast and hotel check-out. Transfer to the airport in Malaga to board our return flight to Boston (*via an intermediate city*) with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available in-flight. (BB)
