Eligibility Requirements:

- **Check with Financial Aid to see if you have eligibility before registering for your summer classes.**
- You must be accepted in a degree-seeking program by the start of the summer term and not be in default or owe a refund of Federal/State Funds.
- **A minimum total of 6 credits in any one summer session or between two sessions is required. YOU MUST REGISTER FOR ALL YOUR SUMMER COURSES BY May 2, 2008.**
- If you are academically dismissed or not making Satisfactory Academic Progress, you will not be eligible for summer or 2007-2008 financial aid.
- **For summer aid, you must have completed and we must have received a 2007 – 2008 Free Application for Federal Student Aid and this summer school application by the April 4 deadline.** (Salem State College Title IV code 002188).
- **Any required verification documentation must be in the Financial Aid Office by Friday, April 25.**

Processing Requirements:

- If you will be living in the dorms or off-campus, you may want to consider borrowing funds to cover room & board as well as tuition, fees, and books. **Emergency loans and book vouchers are not available in the summer.** If you live off-campus, please plan to budget accordingly. *Summer loan disbursement dates vary depending upon your enrollment in Summer I and/or Summer II sessions.*
- **The Financial Aid Office will determine your eligibility for the Federal Stafford Loan. If you already have a Master Promissory Note and an Entrance Loan Counseling Interview on file, you do not need to complete this step.** If this is your first Federal Stafford Loan at Salem State College, you will need to complete the Master Promissory Note and Entrance Loan Counseling Interview at www.salemstate.edu/finaid. You will need your Department of Education Pin # to complete your Master Promissory Note. If you do not have one or misplaced it, you can request it at <http://pin.ed.gov>.
- **Summer Stafford Loan awards will be determined by your remaining Stafford Loan eligibility for the 2007-2008 school year.**
- Any revisions in awards due to changes in registered credits, which may result in charges due the College, are the sole responsibility of the student.
- **Work-study recipients must pick up their Authorization Forms within two weeks of award acceptance or work-study awards will be canceled.** Positions will be posted on the Student Employment bulletin boards located on the 1st floor of the Administration Building.
- **Funds are earned based upon days of attendance. Students not completing summer courses may be subjected to the Return of Title IV policy.** You must take and complete a minimum of six credits to be eligible for Stafford Loan monies.
- **Priority Summer Aid Notification letters will be sent out after May 9, 2008.** Any questions regarding eligibility can be directed to the Financial Aid Office.
- **You must return your signed award letter prior to your last day of classes. If it is returned after this date, all aid will be canceled.**
