Admission to the Undergraduate Physical Education Concentration

The following requirements must be satisfied for matriculation into the Physical Education Concentration:

- A minimum grade of "C" in all SFL major and physical education concentration courses; English Composition I and II and SPC 101, Speech
- A 2.75 grade point average for all courses taken at Salem State College
- A 3.00 grade point average for all SFL major and physical education concentration courses taken at Salem State College
- A passing score on the Communication and Literacy Skills Tests of the Massachusetts Tests for Educator Licensure
- A passing score on the SFL-PETE Introductory Portfolio

The student may submit application for matriculation into the physical education concentration after successful completion of 45 to 60 credit hours and the completion of minimum standards listed above. Matriculation applications are available from the physical education concentration coordinator. **Matriculation** into the physical education is a prerequisite for: SFL 321P, SFL 322P, SFL 420, EDU 462N, EDU 462B, EDU 472N, EDU 472B
