

Groups and Clubs Attendance Policy  
effective 18 January 2007

Total Absences	Consequence
1	5% of the group or club's original budget will be reclaimed by SGA.
2	Budget will be frozen until your (group or club president's) attendance at the next scheduled groups and clubs meeting. An additional 10% of the group or club's original budget will be reclaimed by SGA (15% total).
3	Budget will be frozen until your (group or club president's) attendance at the next scheduled groups and clubs meeting. An additional 5% of the group or club's original budget will be reclaimed by SGA (20% total).
4	Budget will be frozen for the remainder of the semester. An additional 10% of the group or club's original budget will be reclaimed by SGA (30% total).
5	Budget will be frozen for the remainder of the fiscal year.

All groups and clubs, unless otherwise notified in writing, will begin with zero (0) absences 18 January 2007.

Presidents are not required, though are greatly encouraged, to attend Groups and Clubs meetings (unless stipulated otherwise by the Attendance Policy or at the request of the Vice President or Treasurer of the Student Government Association). Any active member of an organization may sign in for their group. No one person may sign in for more than two (2) groups or clubs at the same event. An active member must be a student; advisors are unable to sign in for their groups. If a member is in attendance and forgets to sign in, that will count as an absence.

All funds reclaimed by SGA will be placed in the Finance Committee budget for reallocation to funded groups and clubs by the usual process.
