**DAY 1 – BOSTON~AMSTERDAM:** Depart Boston's Logan International Airport aboard our transatlantic flight to Amsterdam with meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available while in flight.

**DAY 2 – AMSTERDAM~THE HAGUE:** Upon arrival at the airport in Amsterdam, we will meet our Tour Escort, who will take us on a panoramic tour of this truly unique canal-lined Dutch city. Later, we'll transfer to our hotel in The Hague, the Ibis Den Haag City Centre (or similar). Our welcome dinner will be at a local restaurant this evening. Overnight at our hotel. **DAY 3 – DAY AT LEISURE:** After breakfast at our hotel, we are free for the day. Return to our hotel for overnight. (B)

**DAY 4 – AALSMEER~MADURODAM~DELFT:** After breakfast at our hotel, we are off for a full-day "Grand Holland" tour, visiting the famed Aalsmeer Flower Auction. We will also enjoy a panoramic city tour of Delft, a beautiful city known for its pottery and science, before entering Madurodam, the famed park featuring miniature replicas of Holland. Return to our hotel for overnight. (B)

**DAY 5 – DAY AT LEISURE:** After breakfast at our hotel, we are free for the day. Return to our hotel for overnight. (B)

**DAY 6 – BRUGES~GHENT~BRUSSELS:** After breakfast and hotel check-out, we'll enjoy a full-day visit to Bruges and Ghent. In Ghent, we'll see Van Eyck's Masterpiece "The Lamb of God" in St. Bavo's Cathedral. We'll also visit the Holy Blood Basilica in Bruges. **DAY 7 – ANTWERP & BRUSSELS TOURS:** After breakfast, we will enjoy guided city tours of Antwerp and Brussels. Included will be a two-hour walking tour of the Antwerp Diamond District and admission to the Gueuze Museum in Brussels, where we will have a guided tour and learn about the brewing of Belgian lambic beers. A tasting is included. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

**DAY 8 – DAY AT LEISURE:** After breakfast at our hotel, we are free for the day. Return to our hotel for overnight. (B)

**DAY 9 – AMSTERDAM~BOSTON:** After breakfast and hotel check-out, we transfer to Amsterdam's Schiphol Airport to board our return flight to Boston with meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available while in flight. (B)
