In accordance with MGLA Chapter 30A and amended by On March 29, 2023, Governor Healey signed <u>Chapter 2 of the Acts of 2023</u>, which amongst other things, extends the remote meeting provision to March 31, 2025. other things, further extends temporary provisions pertaining to the <u>Open Meeting Law to March 31, 2025</u>. Specifically, this extension allows public bodies to continue holding meetings remotely without a quorum of the public body physically present at a meeting location, and to provide "adequate, alternative" access to remote meetings.
