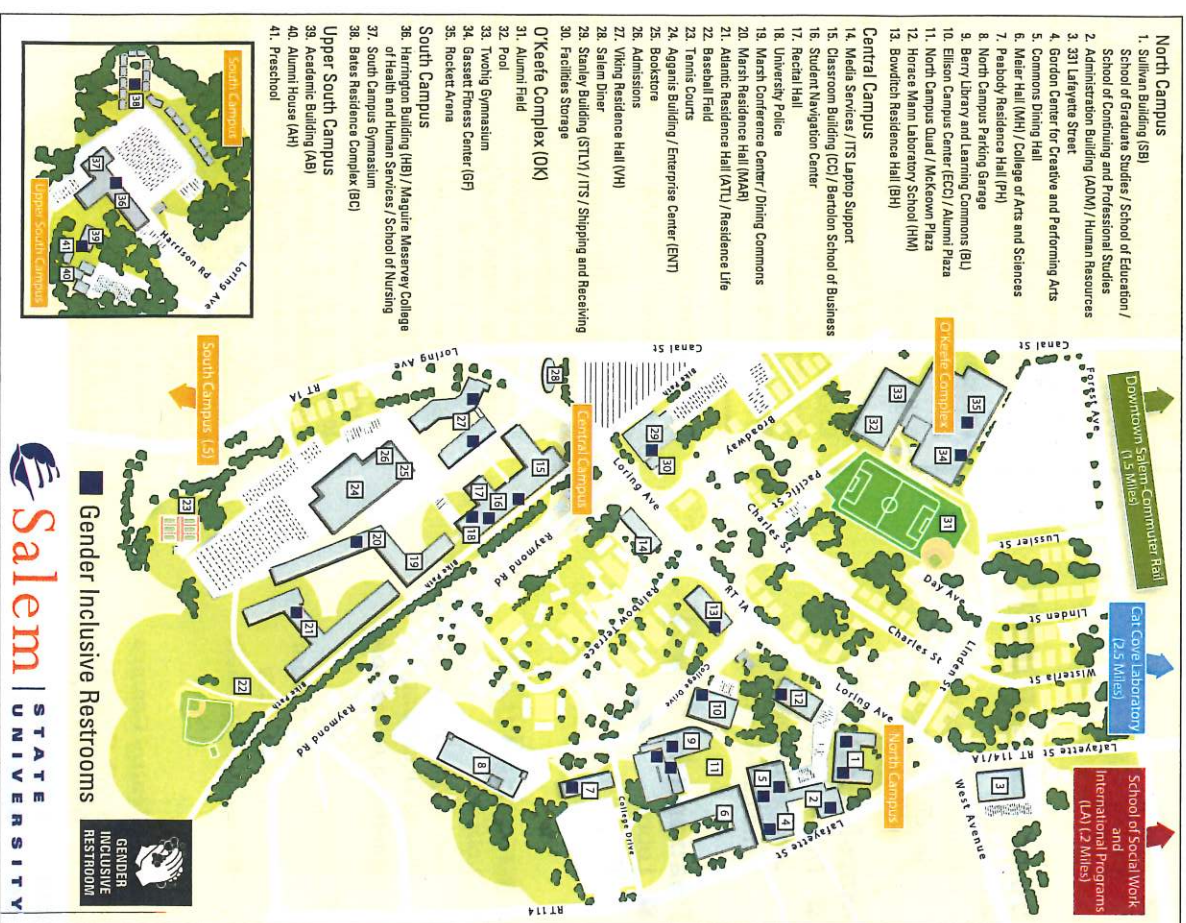

Preferred Name Policy

It is Salem State's policy that students within the university community may choose to use a preferred name different from their legal name to identify themselves. The preferred name policy applies to internal university documents such as class rosters, ClipperCard, canvas etc. A community member's legal/ primary name may appear on many external university documents in addition to any documents that require a legal name such as financial aid, payroll records, transcripts, etc. Legal/ primary name will be used in cases where information is sent to a permanent address. To set up a preferred name, go to your Navigator account and click the full menu tab at the top. Access on this drop down menu should show the option of Personal Profile. Once you click Personal Profile, a second drop down menu of change my preferred first name should appear. Once on this page you can edit your preferred first name.
