

DAY 1 – BOSTON~LONDON: Depart Boston's Logan International Airport aboard our transatlantic flight to London, England with meals and beverage service while in flight.

DAY 2 – ARRIVAL – WELCOME TO LONDON: Upon arrival at London's Heathrow Airport, we will be met by our Tour Escort who will assist us aboard our private motorcoach to transfer to our the hotel, *Holiday Inn Kensington High Street London (or similar)* to check in. The remainder of the day at your leisure. Dinner is on your own and overnight.

DAY 3 – **LONDON:** After breakfast, enjoy a half-day panoramic city tour of London. Discover the iconic landmarks, architectural and cultural diversity, and fascinating history that makes London the most visited city in the world. Your London sightseeing tour will take you on a non-stop precession of recognizable landmarks, including The Houses of Parliament, Big Ben, Westminster Abbey, Buckingham Palace, Trafalgar Square, Nelson's Column, and Marble Arch and much more. Spend the balance of the day at leisure. Dinner on your own and overnight. (B)

DAY 4 – LONDON: After breakfast, enjoy the day at leisure in London. Or you can sign up for an <u>Optional Tour to GREENWICH</u> available for an additional fee (see information below and reservation form for fee.) Dinner on your own and overnight. (B)

<u>OPTIONAL TOUR – GREENWICH:</u> Meet with your driver and English-speaking guide this morning for a full-day excursion to the historic area of Greenwich. Start your day with a Thames River Cruise from Westminster Abbey to Greenwich. Visit the Royal Observatory, home of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT), the Prime Meridian of the world and London's Planetarium. After, enjoy some free time to explore Greenwich on your own, perhaps visiting Greenwich Market or the world-famous Cutty Sark. In the afternoon, visit the Queen's House in Greenwich is an architectural masterpiece and home to an internationally renowned art collection. This bright white villa was at the cutting edge of architecture and design when it was completed in the 1630s. During the 17th century the Queen's House was a royal 'House of Delights': a luxurious retreat for Kings and Queens, a place of pleasure for court favorites, and a thriving studio for artists and craftsmen. Meet your driver and return to your hotel in the late afternoon.

DAY 5 – LONDON: After breakfast, enjoy the day at leisure in London. Or you can sign up for an <u>Optional Tour to OXFORD</u> available for an additional fee (see information below and reservation form for fee.) Dinner on your own and overnight. (B)

<u>OPTIONAL TOUR – OXFORD</u>: Meet with your driver and English-speaking guide this morning for a full-day excursion to Oxford. On arrival, enjoy a walking tour of the city. The city of Oxford grew up around the University of Oxford - one of the world's oldest and most prestigious seats of learning. The importance and wealth of the university is projected through the scale and grandeur of the college buildings throughout the city. Pass some of the oldest colleges such as the 13th Exeter College, the impressive Bodleian Library and Baliol College, which is something of an assembly line for British Prime Ministers. Other Oxford highlights include the pretty Bridge of Sighs which connects two parts of Herford College, the Eagle and Child Pub where famous authors JRR Tolkien and CS Lewis would regularly meet and the sights and smells of the 18th century Oxford Covered Market. Oxford was also the perfect setting for the Harry Potter film series – a real "Hogwartsian" inspiration. Enjoy some free time for an independent lunch and to explore the beautiful city on your own. After, visit the Ashmolean Museum. It is the oldest university museum in the world and houses a fascinating collection of curiosities and priceless works of art. The Ashmolean Museum also has an important collection of archaeological relics. The collections cover several areas, from Egyptian mummies to English silver cutlery, from artificial objects to natural specimens. Meet your driver and return to your hotel in the late afternoon.

DAY 6 – **LONDON:** After breakfast, enjoy the day at leisure in London. Or you can sign up for an <u>Optional Tour to SALISBURY</u> available for an additional fee (see information below and reservation form for fee.) Dinner on your own and overnight. (B)

<u>OPTIONAL TOUR – SALISBURY:</u> Meet with your driver and English-speaking guide this morning for a full-day excursion to Salisbury. Visit Stonehenge. The Neolithic stone circle of Stonehenge in the Wiltshire countryside is one of the most famous wonders of the world. Dating back to approximately 3000 BC, the circle of huge upright and horizontal rectangular stones continues to fascinate academics, spiritualists and visitors. How and why did hundreds of people transport five-ton stones from all over the South of England and Wales to create a monument that has no obvious function? A multitude of theories regarding the origins and purpose of Stonehenge abound some serious and some a little hard to believe but all have their supporters. Stonehenge could have been an elite burial mound, druid temple or ancient observatory and may have been put there by ordinary people, aliens or by Merlin the mythical wizard. Next, continue to Salisbury for a guided walking tour of the city. Meet your driver and return to your hotel.

DAY 7 – LONDON: After breakfast, enjoy the day at leisure in London. Or you can sign up for an <u>Optional Tour to LONDON</u> available for an additional fee (see information below and reservation form for fee.) Dinner on your own and overnight. (B)

<u>OPTIONAL TOUR – LONDON</u>: Meet with your driver and English-speaking guide this morning for a full-day tour of London. Our 1st stop is St Paul's Cathedral, the most recognizable feature of the London skyline. The marble floors, expansive dome murals and Victorian mosaics have provided the backdrop in recent times for the state funerals of Winston Churchill and Margaret Thatcher as well as Jubilee celebrations. Destroyed and rebuilt after the Great Fire of London and an unlikely survivor of the Blitz, the Cathedral has earned a place among London's most popular sights. Climb into the iconic dome for stunning views across London, try out the acoustics of the Whispering Gallery and head down to the crypt to see the tombs of heavyweight historical figures like Admiral Lord Nelson and the Duke of Wellington. Enjoy some free time for independent lunch around the historic Borough Market. After lunch, visit the Tower of London. On the banks of the Thames River in the heart of London stands the Tower of London and nearly 1000 years of history and intrigue. The Tower of London has been used at various times as a palace, barracks, military stronghold, zoo and most famously as a prison incarcerating famous names like Sir Walter Raleigh, Anne Boleyn and Guy Fawkes. During a visit to the Tower visitors can see crown jewels worth over 20 billion, meet the ravens who legends say have the fate of the Kingdom in their claws, talk to the distinctive Yeoman guards with their white ruffs, and learn about the gruesome torture that went on within the walls. The Tower is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the only intact medieval buildings on the list. At the Tower there are also cafes and a shop. Meet your driver and return to your hotel.

DAY 8 – LONDON: After breakfast, enjoy the day at leisure in London. Or you can sign up for an Optional Tour to WINDSOR & WISLEY available for an additional fee (see information below and reservation form for fee.) Dinner on your own and overnight. (B)

<u>OPTIONAL TOUR – WINDSOR & WISLEY:</u> Meet with your driver and English-speaking guide this morning for a full-day excursion to Windsor and Wisley. Visit Windsor Castle, the oldest and largest occupied castle in the world. Admire the magnificent State Rooms, St George's Chapel and Queen Mary's Dolls' House. Witness the colorful and very 'British' spectacle of the guards marching through the streets of Windsor for the Changing the Guard ceremony within Windsor Castle's walls - it's a sight not to be missed! Enjoy some free time in Windsor for an independent lunch. After, we will visit RHS Garden Wisley, one of the UK's most visited and best-loved gardens. Spanning 240 acres, it's both the historic home of RHS and a glorious garden of the future, thanks to a brand-new planet-friendly research center. Meet your driver and return to your hotel.

DAY 9 – LONDON~BOSTON: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will say farewell to London. We'll transfer to London Airport for our return with meals and beverage service while in flight. (B)
