Your cumulative grade point average (GPA) is calculated by dividing the sum of your grade points by the total number of credits you have taken at Salem State College, including any courses you may have failed. Transfer credits, study abroad credits, and courses taken for pass/fail credit or those which have been repeated are not included in your cumulative or major GPA. The grade points you achieve for each class are calculated by multiplying the number of credits for the class by the number equivalent to the letter grade you received (see the key above). To calculate your GPA in your major program of study, you will need to complete the worksheet below. Only include courses taken in your major field of study, but **not** required support courses taken outside your major. Courses in your major include any courses taken under the heading of major or concentration on your flowsheet, as well as any additional courses taken within your major discipline. Remember to leave out any transfer credits!
